Green Travel Plan and Car Parking.

Many parents will recall that we set up a web based travel survey last year as part of our efforts to overcome parking difficulties in West Street, and help co-ordinate shared 'green' travel arrangements. The survey confirmed that many Prebendal families live over a wide area where they have no option other than to travel into Chichester by car. The results also indicated that many parents were willing to car share where possible, or to use a dedicated minibus service if it was viable. The setting up of a parent/staff school travel plan committee was one of the recommendations of the survey in order to progress matters so that an integrated access strategy could be prepared for the school. We are now keen to set this up and are looking for willing volunteers. Please could you let the Bursar know if you are interested in being involved and attending an initial meeting on Thursday 4th November at 9.15am, the venue will be in school but room will be dependent on numbers.
